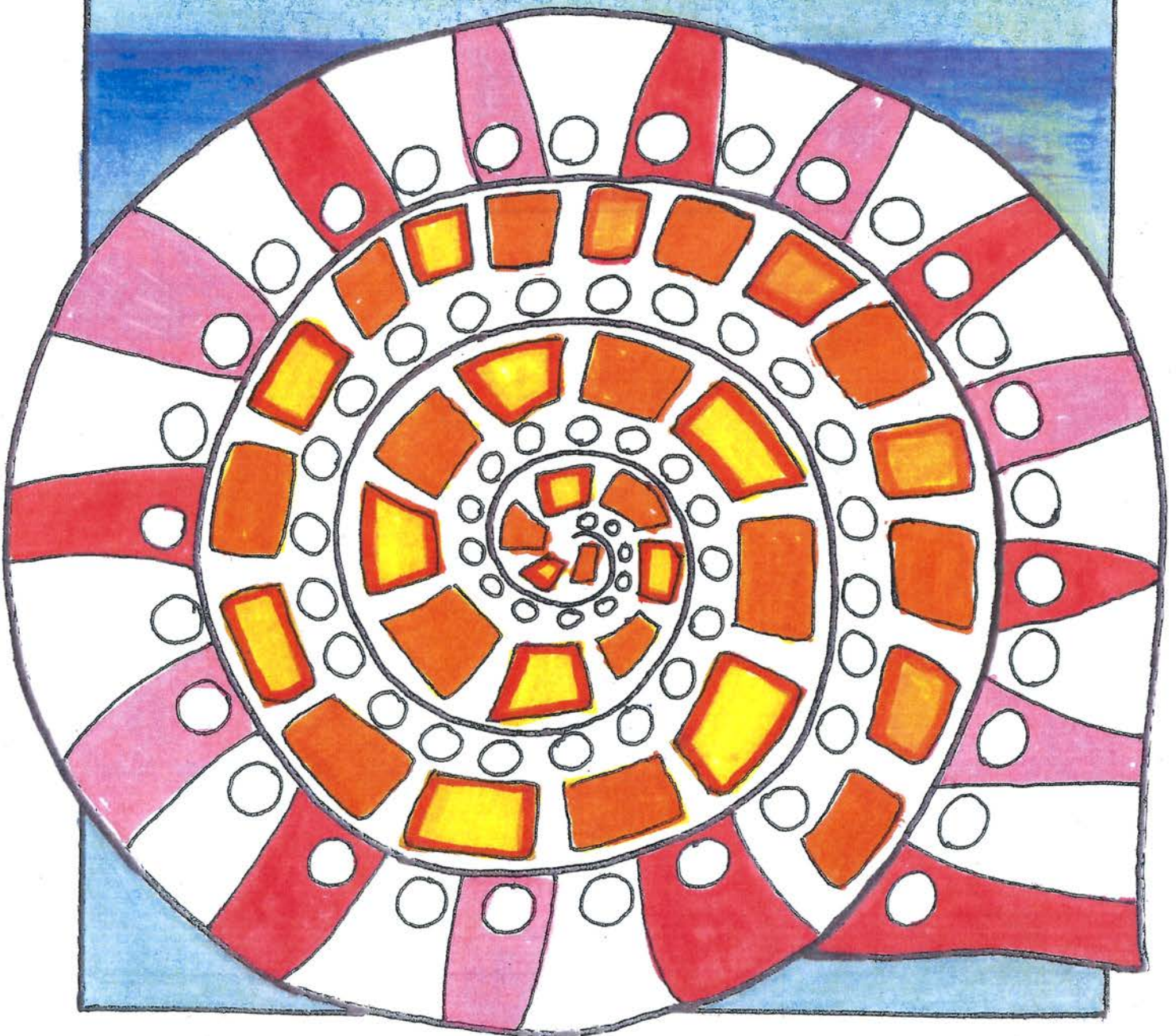

Welcome, You are About to Become an Artist

- Your Art Class recommends an art Portfolio (Binder) for each student with plastic sleeve protectors to put the artwork in.
 - Cardstock is recommended to do the artwork on because it is thicker than regular copy paper, and therefore easier to work on.
 - Your Art Class is encouraged to draw your own rendition of the art lesson if not initially, then eventually.
 - Each lesson has black and white drawings that can be completed using colored pencils, markers, watercolors, or crayons.
 - Encourage yourself, encourage someone else! You are doing great.
 - Pay attention to the background! Make sure it is complete!
 - Check the finished piece to see if it is signed and dated every time.
 - Each student should try to come up with a title for their individual completed art work. Some students may need assistance. It really is a fun activity.

Series D, 1st Qtr, Week 1: **Your Art Class Learns about Capricorn**

This Series of Art lessons will feature the signs of the Zodiac. Astrology is the ancient study of the Zodiac signs. Astrologers claim that the stars and the sun have an effect on personality and psychology. Astrologers even predict what might happen to you, depending on what Zodiac sign you were born in and how the constellations of stars align. A horoscope is an astrologers' predictions, which are made daily, weekly, and monthly. Capricorn is the Zodiac sign for those born between December 22 and January 19. Dates vary with all the astrology signs depending on where you search. Not an exact science. The goat is the symbol for Capricorn and the best qualities of a Capricorn are: Practical, prudent, humorous, reserved, patient, careful, ambitious, and disciplined. The sea goat was the original symbol. When I read that I pictured a ship full of baby goats!!!!

When drawing a goat, even a baby goat, the horns are to the front of the head. I took care of some baby goats once and little bumps for the horns show when they are a few weeks old. If you want to copy one of the black and white drawings, it is suggested to use cardstock. It is thicker and you can use watercolors if you want. I used crayons for the color samples, which are done to give you inspiration, not for you to color exactly.

Music Suggestion: There is an album by Gary Usher titled "The Astrology Album." Diana Ross and the Supremes has a song titled "No Matter What Sign You Are" and is found on their album, "Let the Sunshine In." Great music to inspire you.

Enrichment: There is a painting titled "Young Girl with Goat and Flowers" by Emile Munier. Compare his style with that of Eli Halpin's "Trio of Goats." Another great activity is to watch videos of baby goats. There are many.

Aspect of Art: Balance: Is an aspect of art using components such as contrast and unity, large and small, warm colors and cool colors, rough and smooth. The use of different elements creates balance in the art work.
