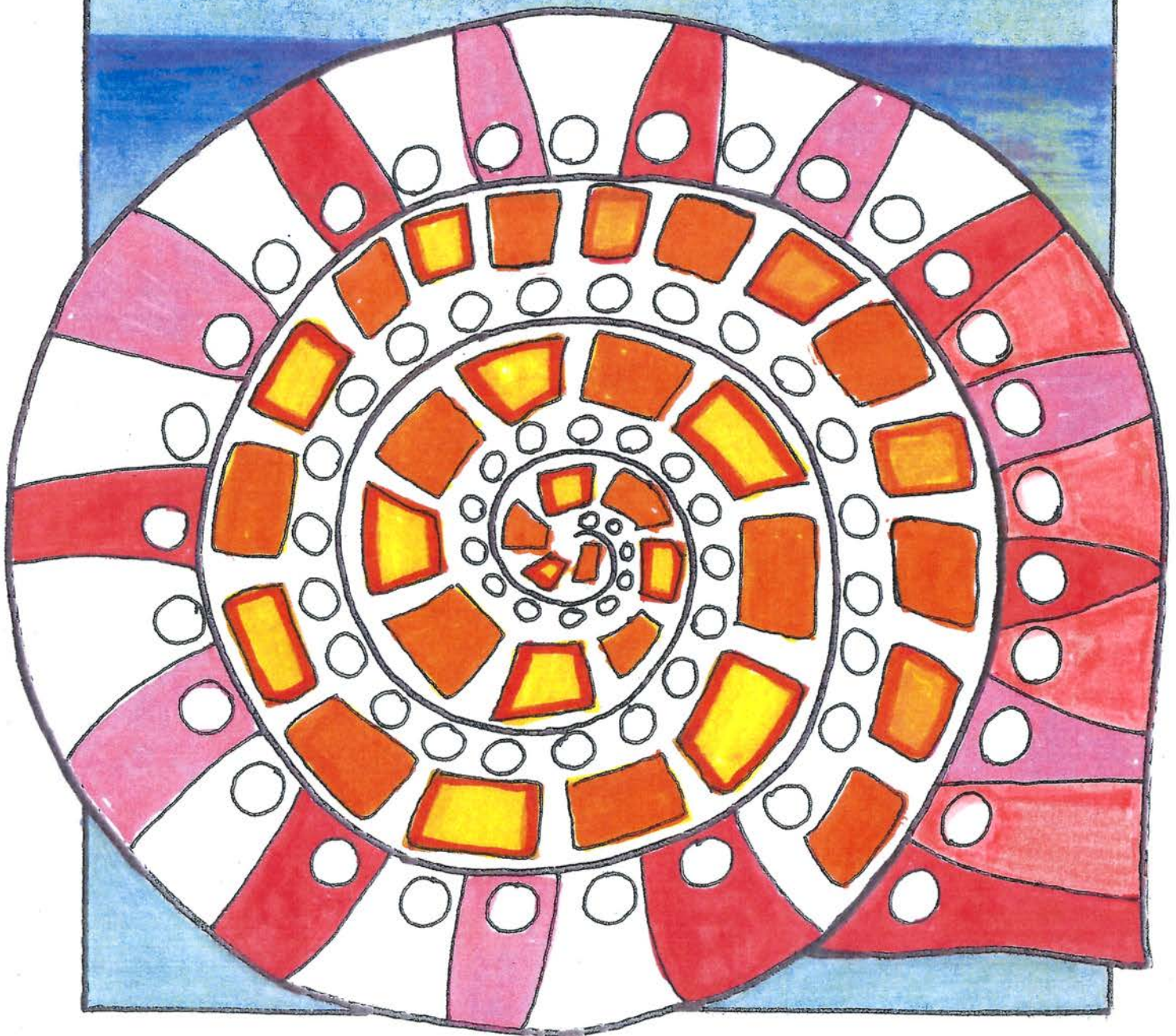

Welcome, You are About to Become an Artist

- Your Art Class recommends an art Portfolio (Binder) for each student with plastic sleeve protectors to put the artwork in.
 - Cardstock is recommended to do the artwork on because it is thicker than regular copy paper, and therefore easier to work on.
 - Your Art Class is encouraged to draw your own rendition of the art lesson if not initially, then eventually.
 - Each lesson has black and white drawings that can be completed using colored pencils, markers, watercolors, or crayons.
 - Encourage yourself, encourage someone else! You are doing great.
 - Pay attention to the background! Make sure it is complete!
 - Check the finished piece to see if it is signed and dated every time.
 - Each student should try to come up with a title for their individual completed art work. Some students may need assistance. It really is a fun activity.

Your Art Class takes on Aires

The symbol for Aires is either sheep with horns or a goat with horns. The Goat has a hair coat and its tail is up and the horns point up and back. The sheep of course have a wool coat and the horns although similar are graded in competition. A ram is actually a male sheep, likes mountainous terrain, and has bigger horns. Aires covers the period from March 21 to April 19. The qualities for Aires are independent, daring, executive, enthusiastic, eager, original, rebellious and ambitious. So Aires can be a Billy goat or a ram. I'm going with the ram since Capricorn is a goat.

Draw your own ram's head with the interesting horns. Or copy one of the black and white drawings. The aspect of art is repetition so repeat the pattern to create interest.

Music Suggestion: In the year 1959 James Van Husen wrote the music and Sammy Cahn wrote the lyrics to "High Hopes" for the movie "A Hole in the Head." Eddie Hodges and Frank Sinatra sang it in the movie. This inspirational song got an Oscar in 1960 from the Best original song for a movie.

Enrichment: A traditional pastoral landscape with sheep is "Sheep Resting on a Riverbank" by Henri de Beul (1845-1900). The famous German-American landscape artist, Albert Bierstadt (1830-1902) did "Rocky Mountain Big Horn Sheep." Try "Ram" by Ed Hofer. You may want to watch the movie "A Hole in the Head."

Aspect of Art: Repetition: Involves a certain shape, stroke, technique, pattern, or color used several times to strengthen the unity of the art. **Repetition in Design:** A plan or method using Repetition. Shape, color, and texture are repeated.



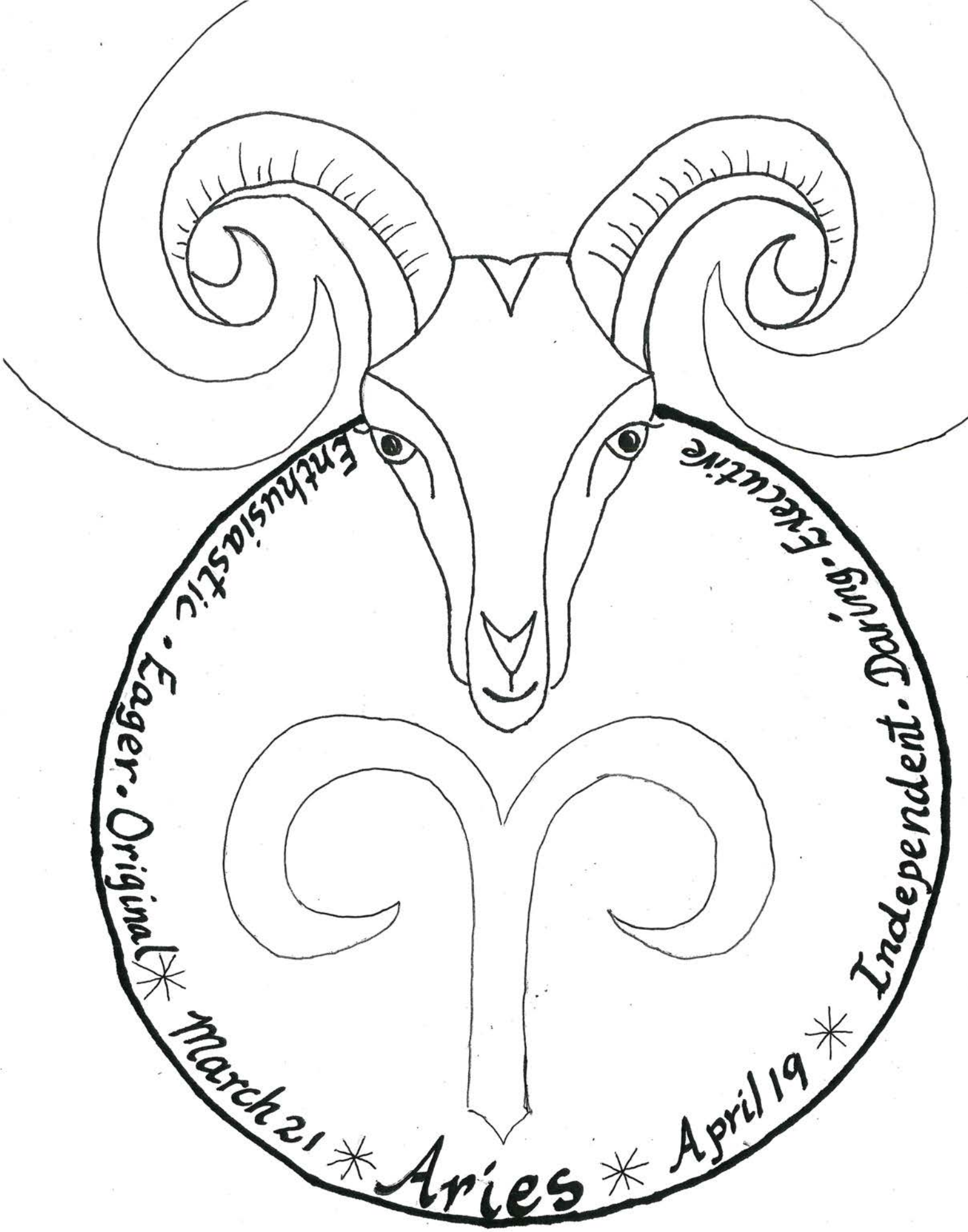

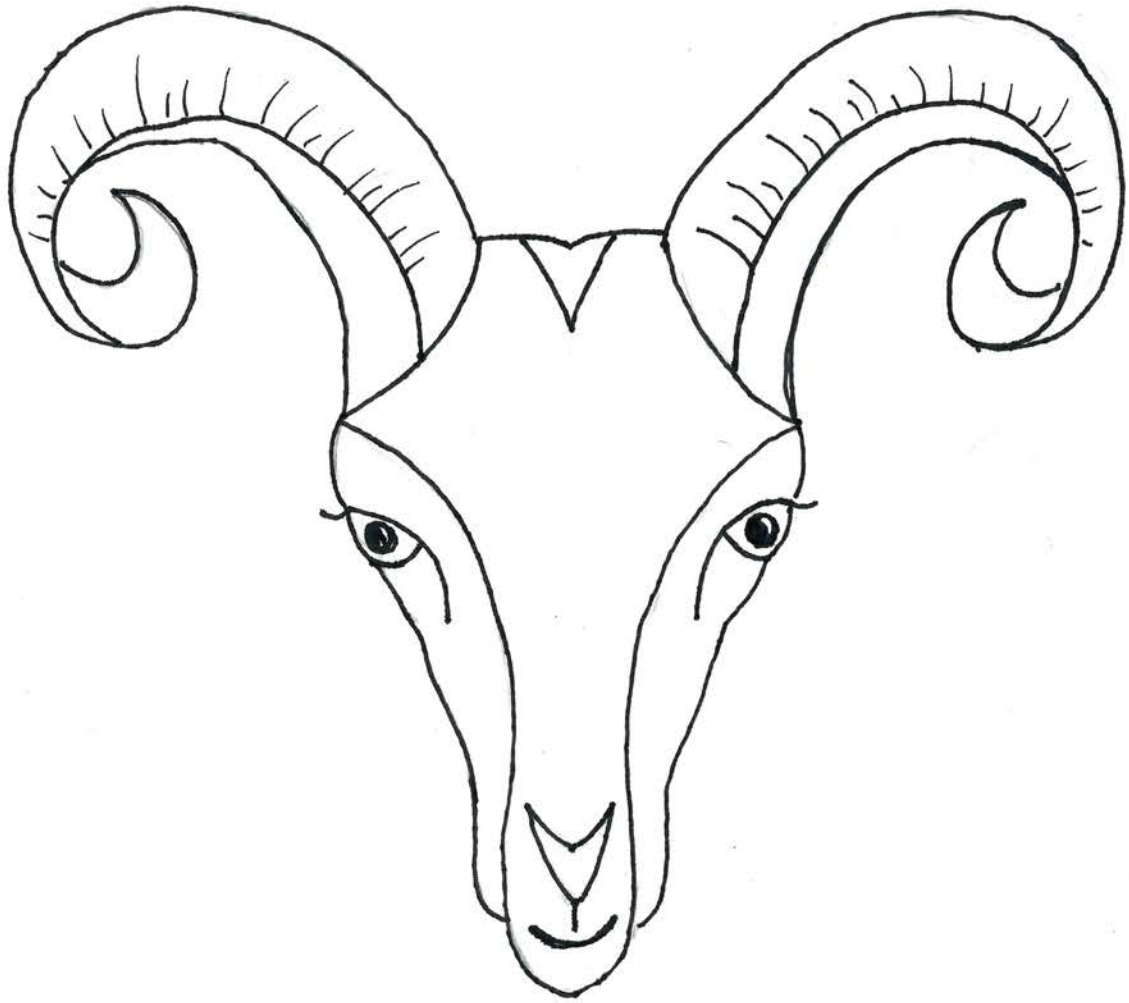

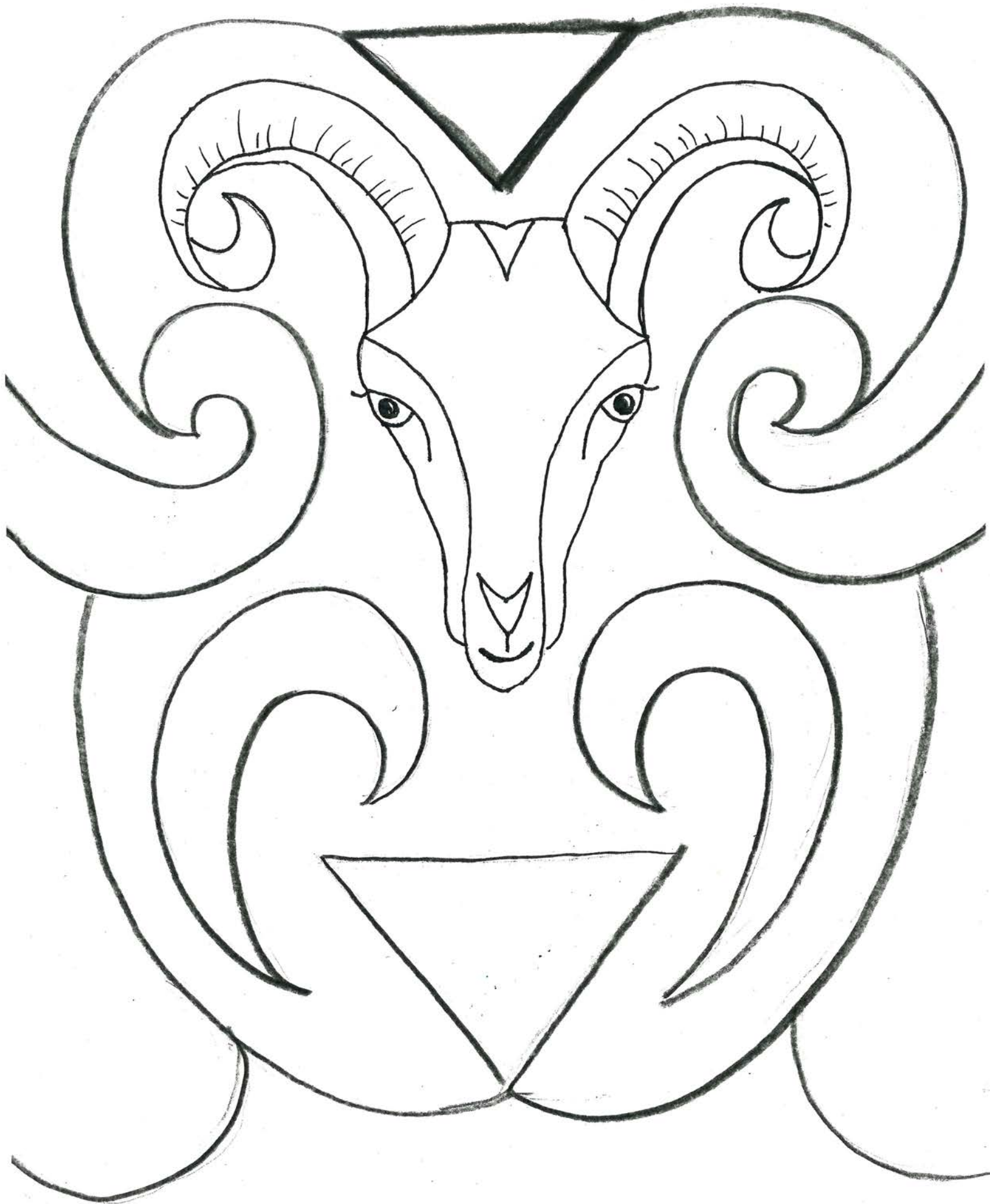
