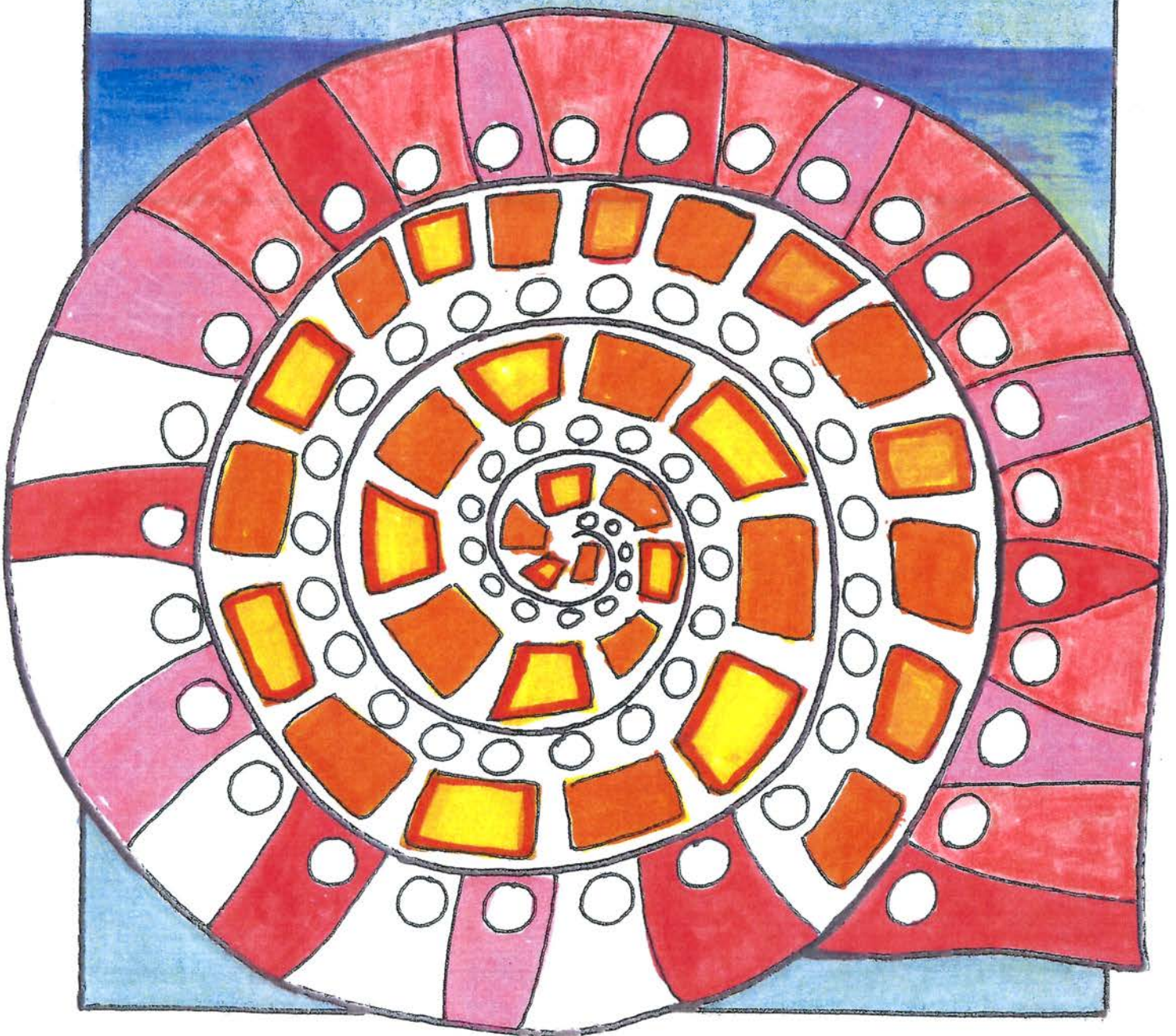

*Welcome, You are About to Become an Artist*

- Your Art Class recommends an art Portfolio (Binder) for each student with plastic sleeve protectors to put the artwork in.
  - Cardstock is recommended to do the artwork on because it is thicker than regular copy paper, and therefore easier to work on.
  - Your Art Class is encouraged to draw your own rendition of the art lesson if not initially, then eventually.
  - Each lesson has black and white drawings that can be completed using colored pencils, markers, watercolors, or crayons.
  - Encourage yourself, encourage someone else! You are doing great.
  - Pay attention to the background! Make sure it is complete!
  - Check the finished piece to see if it is signed and dated every time.
  - Each student should try to come up with a title for their individual completed art work. Some students may need assistance. It really is a fun activity.

*Your Art Class Visits the Crab*

The word cancer came from the word crab or canker. This is why the Horoscope sign for June 21 until July 22 is the crab and is called Cancer. People born during this time are said to be emotional, diplomatic, intense, impulsive, and selective. Crabs have hard armored shells to protect their emotional side. They have pinchers that they use to communicate in a diplomatic way. Crabs are intense at cleaning away debris from the ocean. They walk and swim sideways and are impulsive to change direction at any time. Crabs have been around for over 200 million years which means they are very selective in their choices. Your Art Class can appreciate the crab!

**Draw one or more crabs with a contemporary point of view. In other words, don't try to be realistic; just capture the nature of the crab. You can also copy one of the black and white drawings of the crab on card stock.**

Music Suggestion: Several music suggestions for this lesson are: "Ironic" by Alanis Morissette because it is ironic that Cancer is the name for this horoscope sign. "Manteca" by Ella Fitzgerald (1917- 1996) who sings "Things aren't what they used to be." Adele sings "Water under the Bridge" and the crab is the bridge.

Enrichment: There is a museum in Ocean Springs, Mississippi, the Walter Anderson Museum of Art. Walter Anderson (1903-1965) had an unbelievable affection and alliance with nature, especially the creatures, and did many drawings and paintings of crabs. He was schizophrenic, and perhaps that gave him insight.

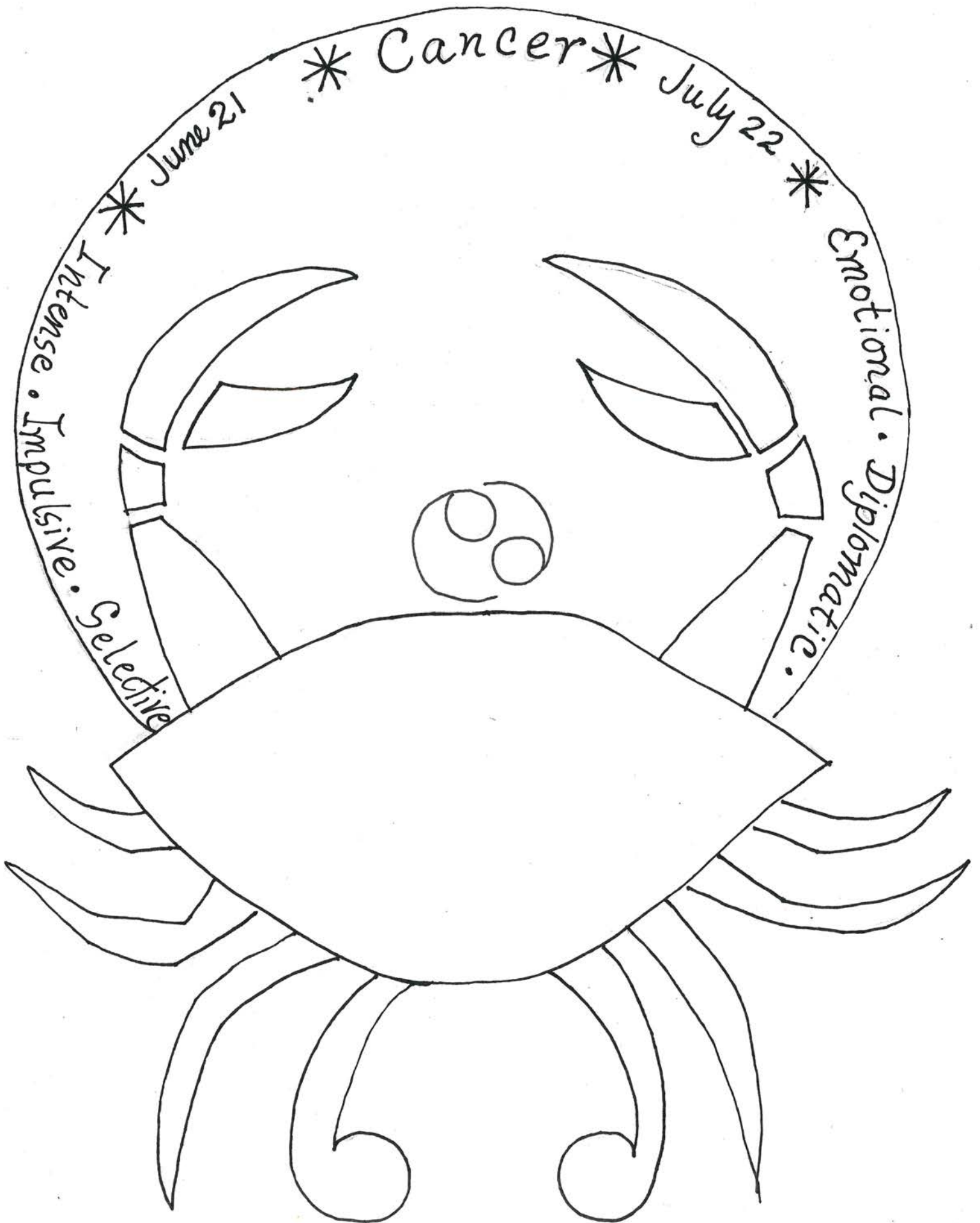
Aspect of Art: Contemporary: This style of art refers to any current or modern day artwork. There are many contemporary artists working today, such as, Your Art Class students.

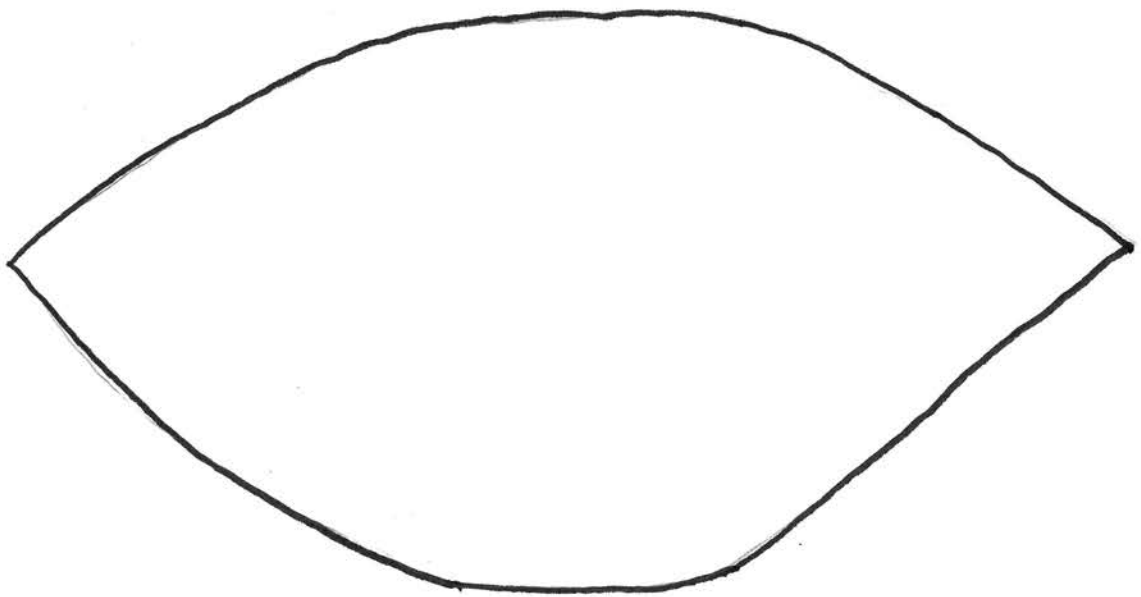

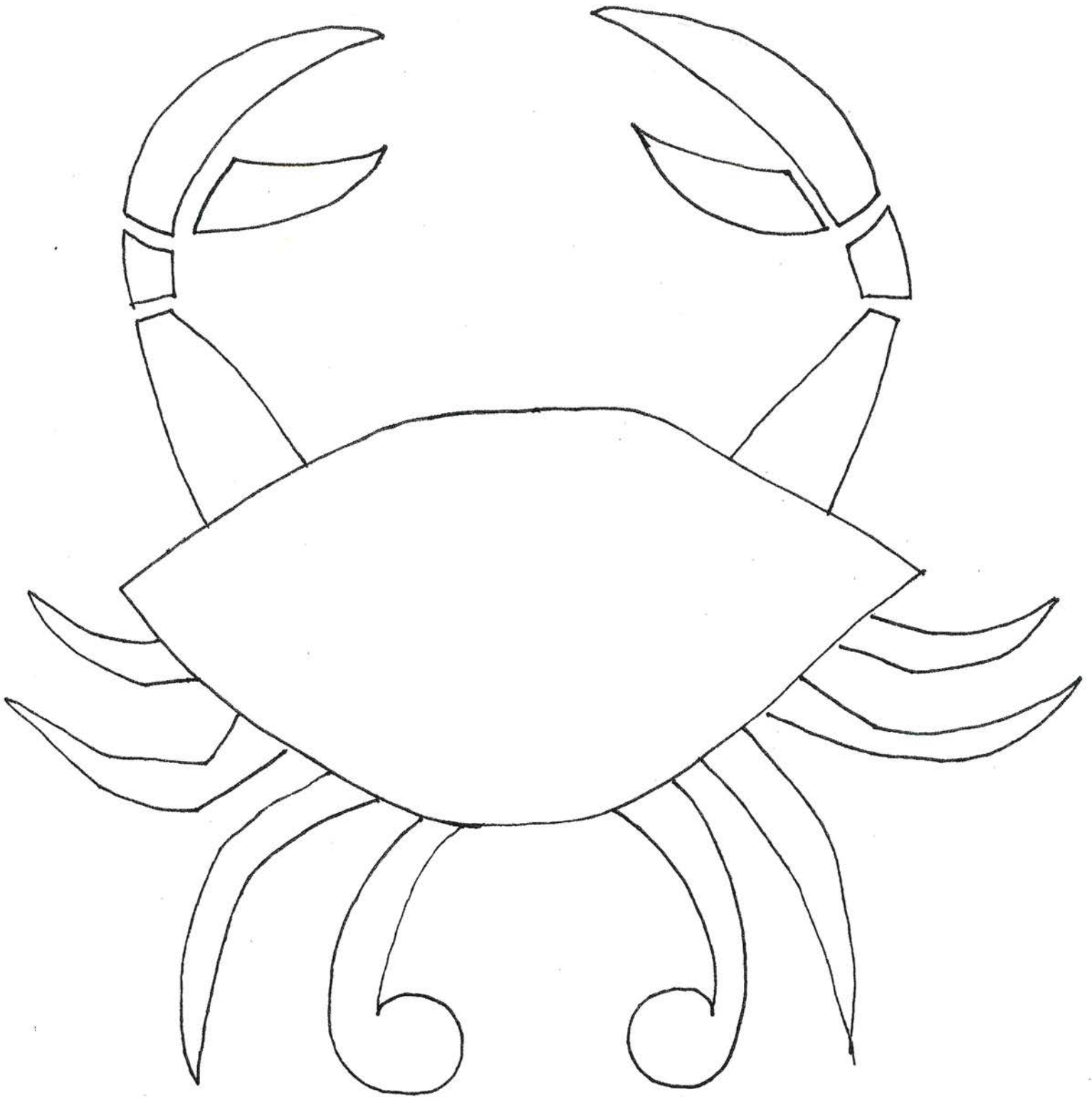

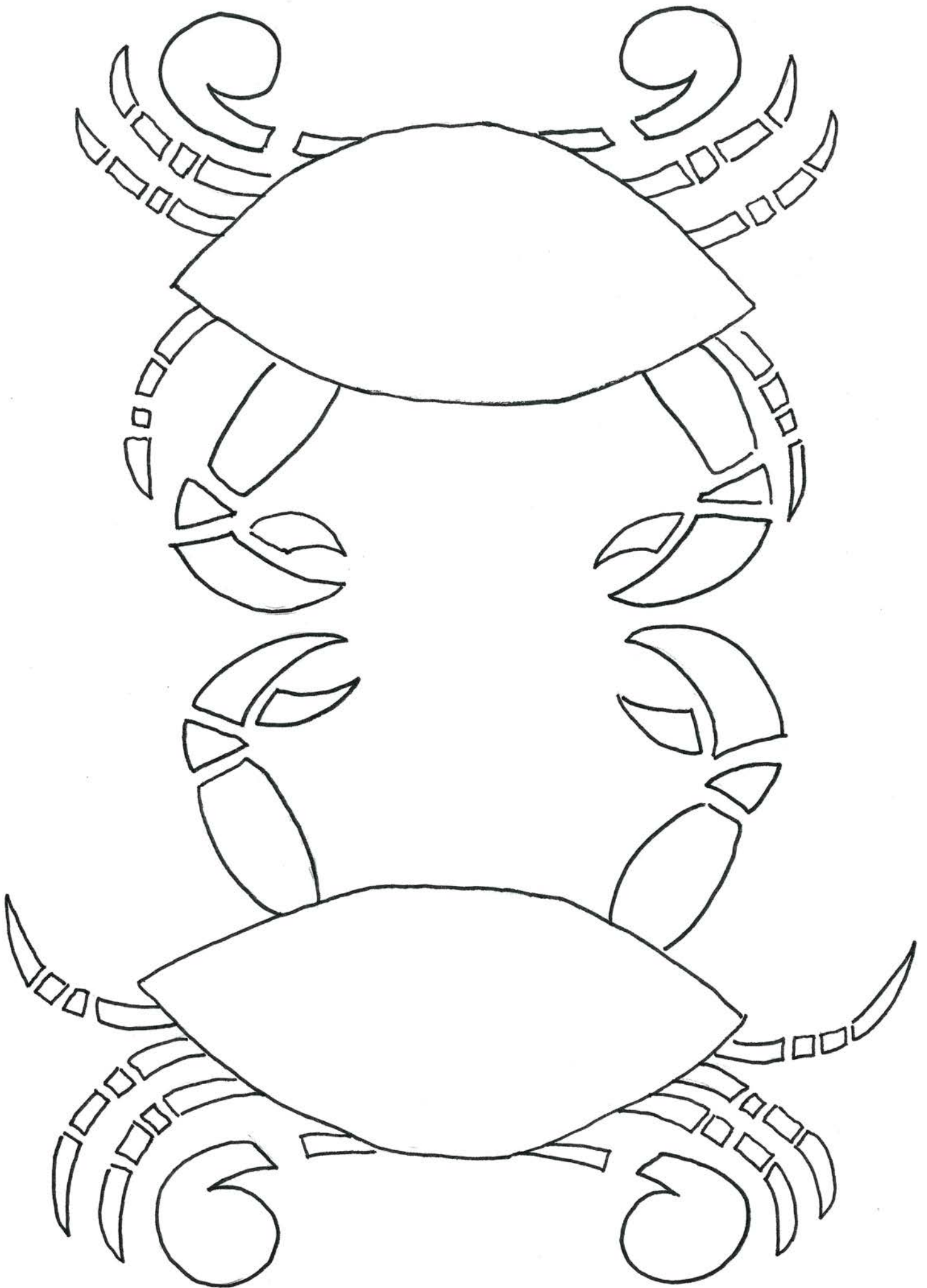
